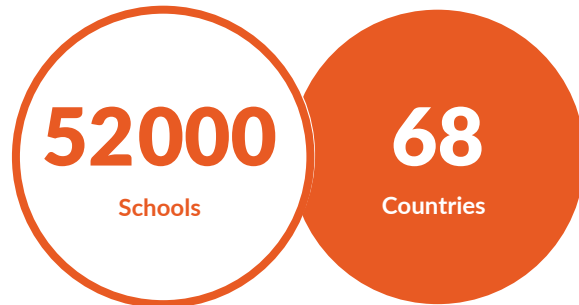
# About the Eco-Schools programme
