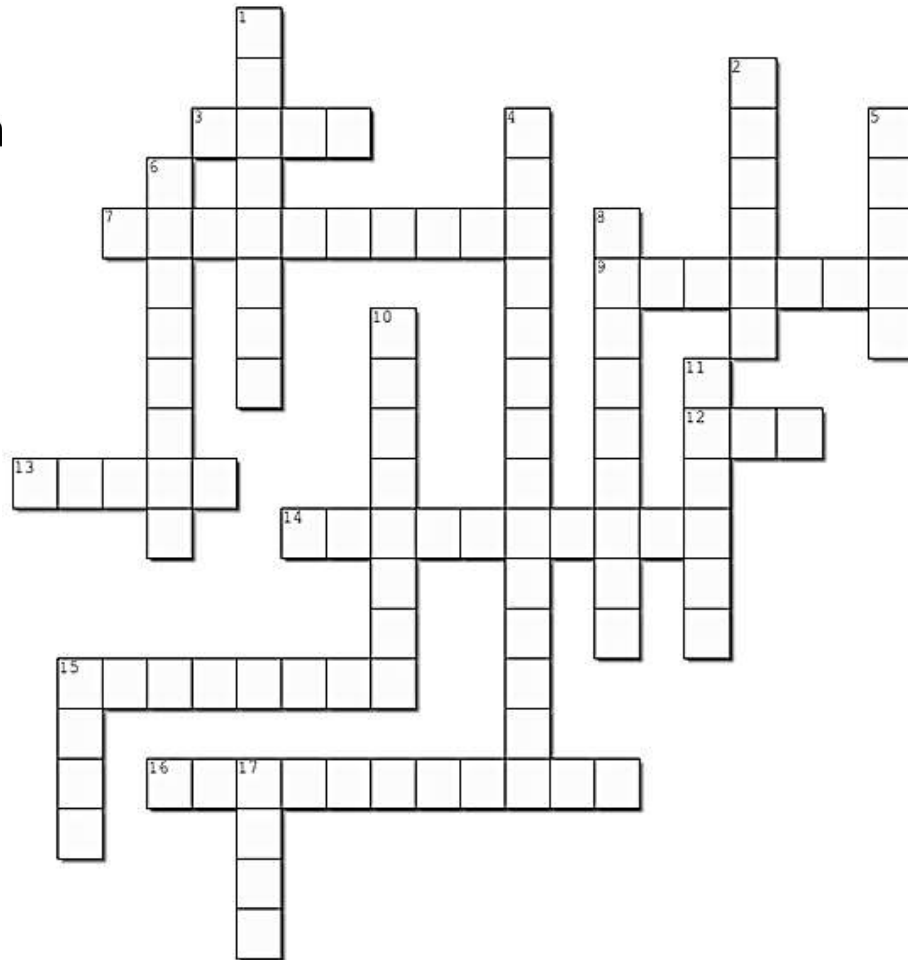
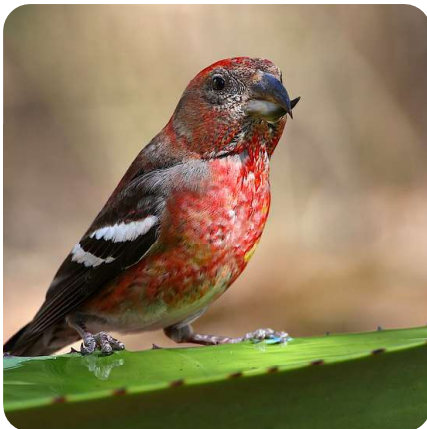


# Hispaniolan Crossbill Crossword
