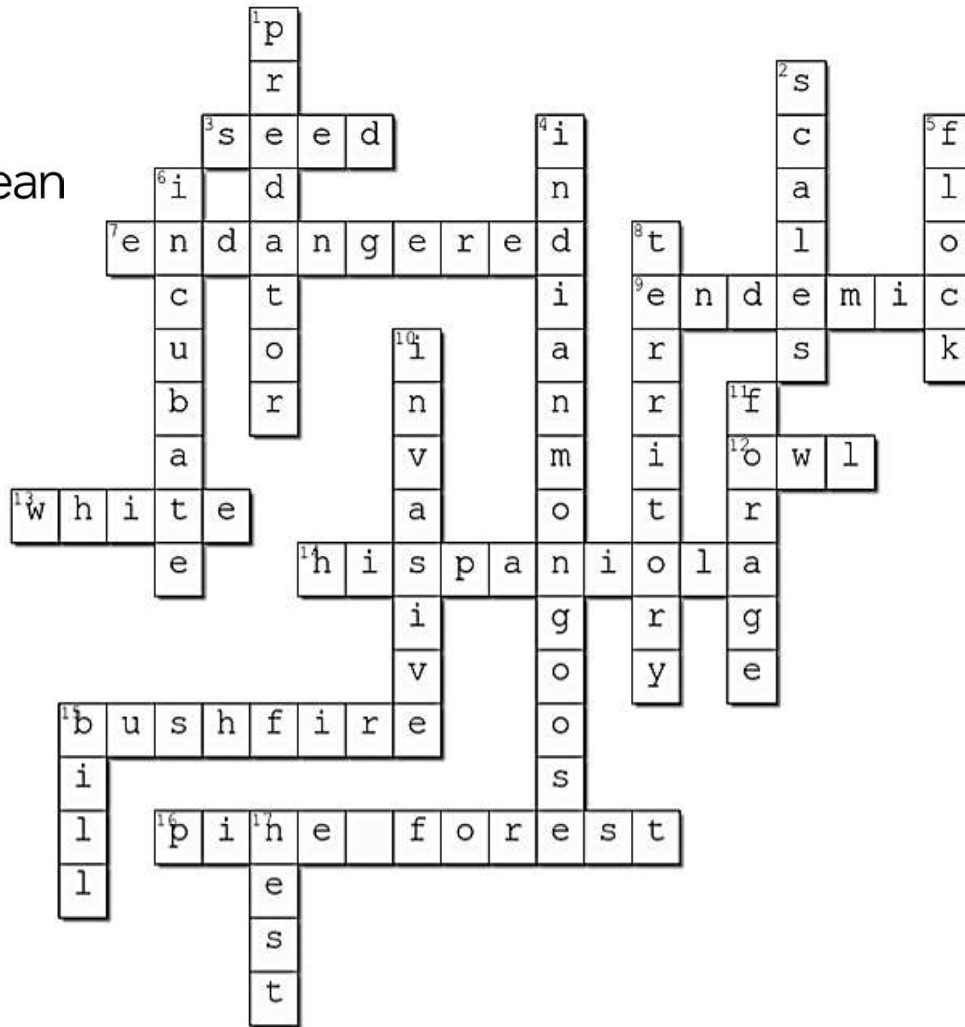
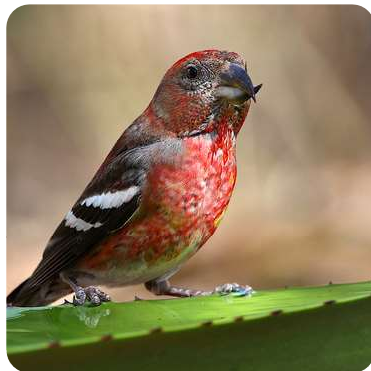


Hispaniolan Crossbill Crossword
