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| 1. IENCEMD | a word used to describe a plant or animal that lives only in a particular location |
| 2. TIAIH | one of two Caribbean country where the Black-capped Petrel is known to nest |
| 3. STNE | a structure or place a bird uses for laying eggs and raising chicks |
| 4. ADTNOBILI | local name for the Black-capped Petrel in Haiti, Dominican Republic and Dominica |
| 5. LCGEPAI | relating to or living in the open sea |
| 6. ISDQU | a soft-bodied mollusc which the Black-capped Petrel feeds on |
| 7. NGEERDDENA | a species considered to be facing a very high risk of extinction in the wild |
| 8. RADPTREO | an animal that preys on others |
| 9. OGSEOOMN | a predator that feeds on Black-capped Petrel eggs |
| 10. LOOLNPTUI | the addition of any harmful matter (liquid, gas or solid) to the environment |
| 11. LRPETE | a type of seabird that spends most of its life away from land |
| 12. ORVNTCAOSNEI | the protection and wise use of natural resources |
