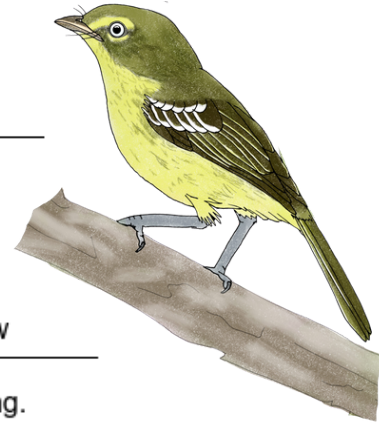


Flat-billed Vireo Facts
