What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly to the Dominican Republic

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Santo Domingo, the capital and largest city in the Dominican Republic. As the oldest continuously inhabited European settlement in the Americas, Santo Domingo has a rich heritage that greets you in the eclectic mix of Victorian houses, palm tree-lined boulevards, modern shopping centers, and traditional eateries.

Day 2: Santo Domingo | Jarabacoa

- Dive into island life with an expert-led sightseeing tour of the city.
- Visit Alcázar de Colón, a palace built by Christopher Columbus's son in the early 1500s.
- Visit Tres Ojos Caves, a series of caves dotted with freshwater lagoons located in the eastern tip of Parque Mirador del Este.
- Travel to Jarabacoa.

Day 3: Jarabacoa

- Enjoy a whitewater rafting excursion.
- Begin your conference experience at El Instituto del Ambiente, where you'll work with the Brigada Verde, a local Dominican student organization dedicated to tackling environmental topics affecting the island and the world.

Day 4: Jarabacoa

- Attend lectures, participate in work-shops, and complete hands-on activities with local students throughout the Brigada Verde conference.

Day 5: Jarabacoa

- Spend your final Brigada Verde conference day presenting solutions to today's most pressing ecological issues.

Day 6: Jarabacoa | Santiago

- Travel to Santiago.
- Depart for home.

2-DAY TOUR EXTENSION

Day 6: Jarabacoa | Northern coastal region

- Transfer to the Northern coastal region.
- Relax at one of the white sand beaches located along the Northern coastal region and find out why the island has become a popular travel destination among ocean lovers.

Day 7: Northern coastal region | Santiago

- Explore Cayo Arena mangroves during a snorkeling tour.
- Travel to Santiago.
